## Conditional sentences

# Second Conditional

- The second Conditional is formed in this way:  
if + **Past Simple**, **would / could / might + infinitive**  
If I **had** enough money, I **would buy** a new car.
- We use the Second Conditional:  
To talk about imagined, impossible or unlikely events in the future.

# THIRD CONDITIONAL

- The Third Conditional is formed in this way:  
if + **Past Perfect**, **would/could/might** + **Perfect Infinitive**

If I **had studied** more, I **would have passed** the exam.

- We use the Third Conditional to talk about unreal situations in the past and to imagine things that did not happen.

If I **hadn't broken** my leg, I **would have gone** skiing.

	Condition	Result
Zero	<b>If + Present Simple</b> If you take the street on the right	<b>Present Simple</b> It's quicker
First	<b>If + Present Simple</b> If I finish work early	<b>Will/won't + V1</b> I'll go to the shop
Second	<b>If + Past Simple</b> If I wasn't sick	<b>Would/wouldn't + V1</b> I'd go to the party
Third	<b>If + Past Perfect</b> If I'd left earlier	<b>Would/wouldn't have + V3</b> I wouldn't have been late
