Were

Examples:

I **was** at the school yesterday

He **was** tired after the football match

She **was** very happy last week

It **was** a cloudy day.

We **were** with our friends last month.

You **were** at the supermarket last Friday.

They **were** at the stadium on Saturday.

Negative form

I
She
He
It

Was + not = **wasn't**

We
You
They

Were + not = **weren't**
