<b>?</b> Question	<b>Were</b> they happy?	<b>Was</b> she rich?

# WAS - WERE SHORT ANSWERS

**PRESENT** Are you happy? Yes, I am.

**PAST** Were you happy? Yes, I was.

## NEGATIVE SHORT ANSWERS

Was I correct?  
Was I early?

Yes, you were.

No, you weren't.

Were **you** busy yesterday?  
Were **you** cold last night?

Yes, I was.

No, I wasn't.

Were **you and John** ready?  
Were **you both** embarrassed?

Yes, we were.

No, we weren't.

Were **they** hungry?  
Were **Mike and Jack** worried?

Yes, they were.

No, they weren't.

Was **he** late again?  
Was **Steve** frustrated?

Yes, he was.

No, he wasn't.

Was **she** a good student?  
Was **Mary** at home last night?

Yes, she was.

No, she wasn't.

Was **it** difficult?  
Was **your dog** sick last week?

Yes, it was.

No, it wasn't.
